

Welcome, Lamb of God Chapel Adorers

Here are the *revised* safety guidelines for all adorers.

May 2021

- 1. Mask requirements are set by the diocese. They are optional if you are fully vaccinated.**
- 2. The HEPA air filter will continue to filter the chapel air.**
- 3. All the chapel chairs will be moved back into the chapel Memorial Day Weekend, 2021. Adorers may sit wherever they are comfortable.** Social distancing requirements are dropped at that time.
- 4. There is hand sanitizer for your use at the touchscreen.** Please do not use disinfectant wipes on the surface of the touchscreen, as they can damage the surface.
- 5. Anyone feeling sick should not enter the chapel.** Committed Adorers, please obtain a substitute and contact your division leader.
- 6. No need to disinfect the chairs – 90-day cleaner is sprayed on the chairs, doorknobs, etc. and will be repeated before 90 more days.**
- 7. Holy water is back in the font.** Every weekend the font is emptied, cleaned, disinfected, and refilled by chapel committee members.
- 8. Visitor sign-in is optional.**
- 9. Committed Adorers and subs:** Please check the touchscreen to be sure that the next committed adorer has signed in before you leave (green dot).
- 10. Visitors are welcome from 6AM to 10PM daily. 10PM to 6AM is for scheduled adorers only.**
- 11. Please remember to maintain silence.** Except for the praying of the 12PM Rosary, the 3PM Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Children's Hour 10AM on Tuesdays, and Vianney Cenacle noon on Saturdays.
